It's BYO everything so please put this in your calendar.

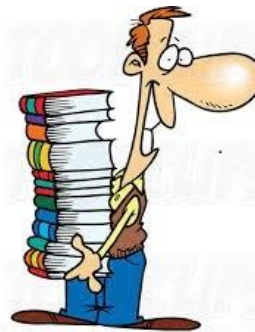
## Christmas Raffle Baskets
