If you wish to join the group please ring Geraldine Monaghan on 9569 3570.

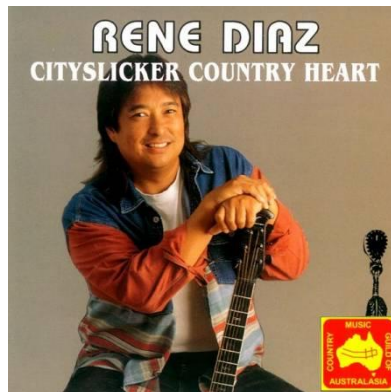
The next Games Day will be held on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> of Febuary commencing at 1:30pm at Pam Ryan's home in Murrumbeena.
