The **Card Group** play Five Hundred on the first and third Mondays of each month at Geraldine’s home in Caulfield South.

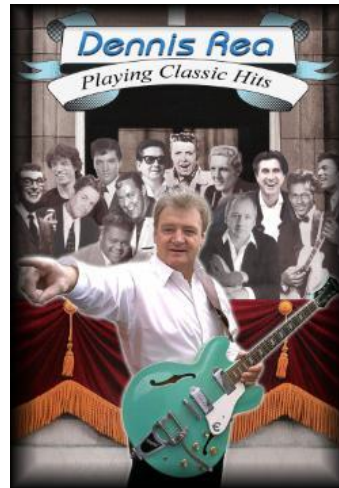

The Tramway Museum houses one of the largest tramway collections in Australia.

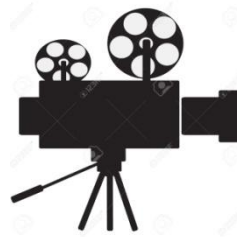
Lunch will be at the Kilmore RC Trackside Bistro.
